What do the Friends do?

- Through well planned working bees we undertake maintenance and restoration of the native trees and plants along the creek and in the Park
- We look after the remnant Grey Box grassy woodland that is a threatened ecosystem in the Adelaide region
- We work with school groups and company groups to prepare new planting sites and encourage others to adopt special areas to maintain and watch the growth and rejuvenation of the local plants
- **The Friends value the Cultural and Historic Heritage that is part of the Park** – we encourage the preservation and restoration of this Heritage through local and State organisations
- We assist with the use of the Park for education and learning experiences through engagement with programs like *Waterwatch*, *Saltwatch*, *Frog Census* and the *Great Australian Marsupial Nightstalk*
- We help maintain the Wirraparinga Walking Trail (part of the Yurrebilla Trail) and the Shared Use Trail for walkers, bike and horse riders that goes through the length of the Park
- We assist with KESAB Clean Up Australia Day in rubbish removal within the Park
- Members have access to free Certified Training in Bush Regeneration, use of power equipment for plant maintenance, safe herbicide handling and first aid
- We support **No Dam in Brownhill Creek**. There are other options
